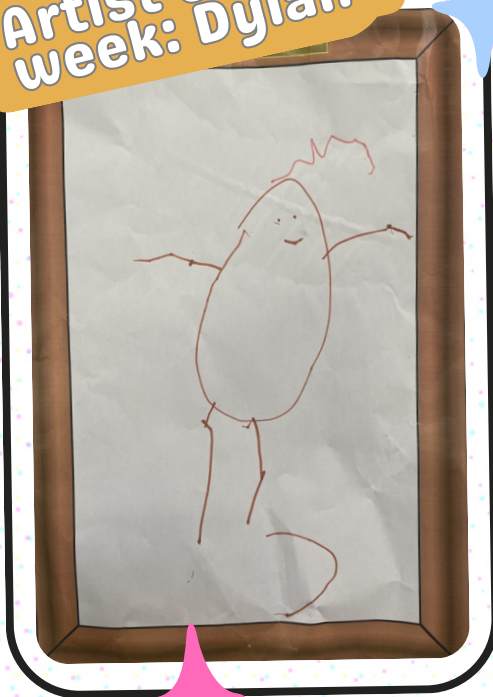
European Day of Languages. Children are invited to wear red, white and blue to school as we celebrate France!

Useful Information:

Supporting your child with reading

Although your child will be taught to read at school, you can have a huge impact on their reading journey by continuing their practice at home.

There are two types of reading book that your child may bring home:

A reading practice book. This will be at the correct phonic stage for your child. They should be able to read this fluently and independently.

A sharing book. Your child will not be able to read this on their own. This book is for you both to read and enjoy together.

In addition your child can login to **Collins E-Books** and share their group practice book at home.

In phonics this week, the children have enjoyed listening for phonemes to play lots of different orally blending games.
