Fundraiser

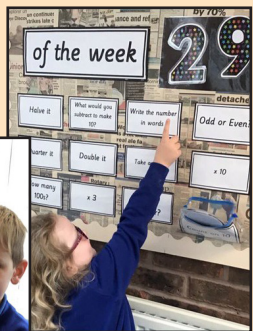
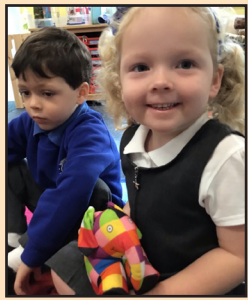
