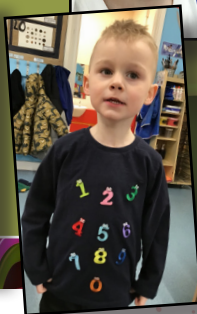

Early Learners have notified us that they now have spaces in their after school club and on the bus. Please contact them if you are interested.

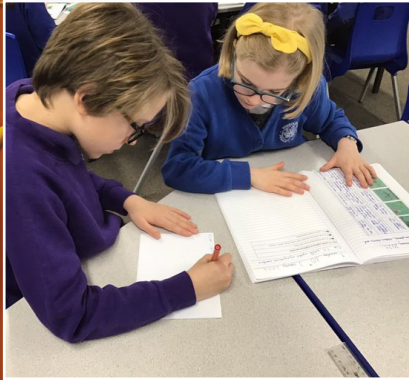
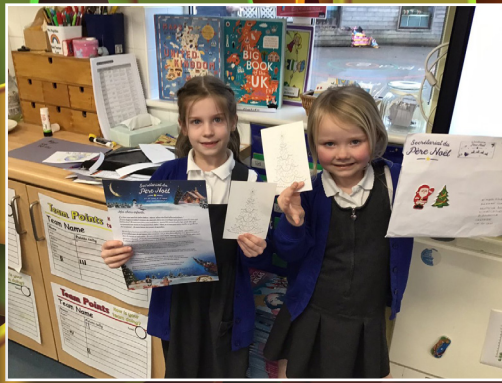
