Graduation Day

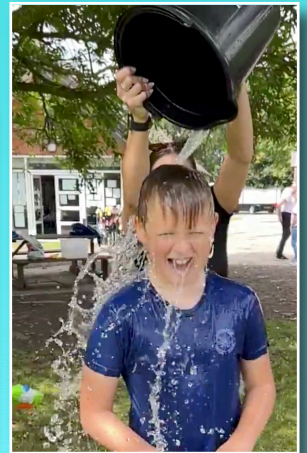
