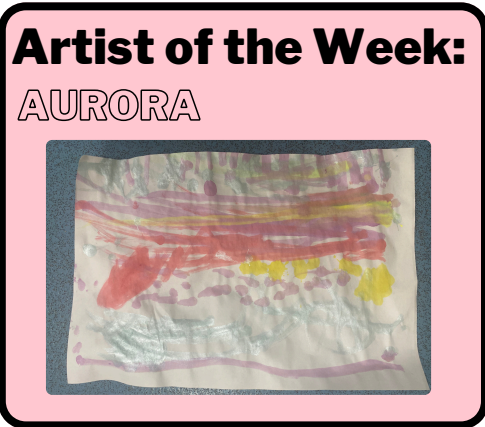
Class News:

Phonics:

This Week's learning

We're teaching every child to read with Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised. A complete SSP validated by the Department for Education.

 i	 iguana	Put your lips back and make the i sound at the back of your mouth. i i i	Down the iguana and dot the leaf.
 n	 net	Open your lips a bit, put your tongue behind your teeth and make the nanna sound nanna .	Down, up and over the net.
 m	 mouse	Put your lips together and make the mummm sound mummm .	Down, up and over the mouse's ears.
 d	 duck	Put your tongue to the top and front of your mouth and make a quick d sound d d d .	Round the duck's body, up to its head and down to its feet.
