In our maths lessons this week, we have continued to explore how numbers to five can be composed of smaller numbers.

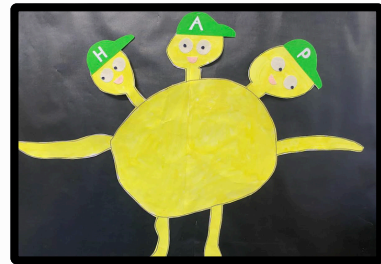
Dough Disco sessions started this morning, and the children all loved a little Dolly Parton to work out their fine motor muscles.
